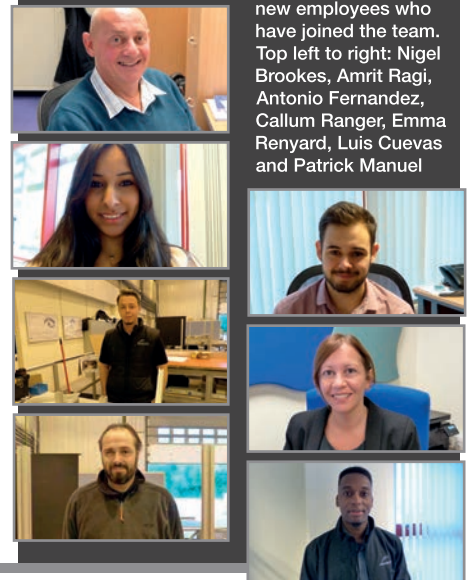

Thinking Space Systems Pty Ltd has recently completed the installation of control room furniture at the new operations centre purpose-built for Parramatta Council. In a rolling programme of improvements to public safety and security within the suburb of Sydney, the new CCTV control room will eventually be monitoring eighty cameras around the city of Parramatta. The new control room was designed by Thinking Space, who understand the demands such environments have on operators and their equipment. A twin console and two separate single operator consoles, along with an Evolution media wall were designed, manufactured and exported from the United Kingdom.

"We approached Thinking Space Systems who were known to us, and therefore we felt confident that we were in good hands when it came to designing our

new control room" explained Rob Williams, Community Crime Prevention Officer, Parramatta City Council. Radar consoles head to the Middle East

Thinking Space Systems has recently completed the manufacture and installation of radar consoles accommodating 88 operators and 4 supervisor/supervisor admin positions. The project took around six months to manufacture, with clients attending a Critical Design Review as well as a Factory Acceptance Test of the completed consoles at the factory in Hampshire. The consoles are currently being installed at two sites in the Middle East.

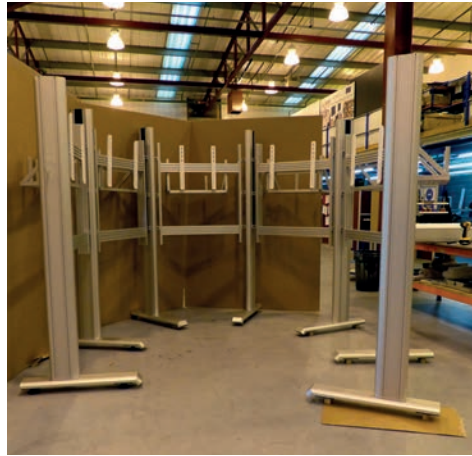


Simulator media wall

Thinking Space have recently completed a custom designed media wall for a Middle Eastern client. The media wall consists of six hinged sections, giving a rotation extension system to hold six 42 inch flat screen monitors. This will give the client more flexibility for positioning the media wall in their environment, an ATC simulator facility.

In addition, the media wall has been fitted with aluminium perforated plates behind each mounting bracket, so that a PC can be mounted locally, at the rear of each screen.

The media wall includes cable management and individually tilting cross beams for sound ergonomic viewing. The whole media wall was assembled in the factory and then powder coated in matt black to the clients requirements, before being shipped to the Middle East.



Custom designed workbenches for Defence Contractor

A large batch of workbenches in a variety of design configurations have recently been provided to a Midlands-based Defence Contractor. The new workbenches were designed and constructed using the Kanya aluminium build system. Typical features include drawer units, overhead lighting and power supplies. Audio media desks for Rahaleo Studios
